Teachers' notes

As the Arabic alphabet is completely different from the Latin, there are some samples of the Arabic script shown, together with the transliteration (approximate pronunciation in English) so that students can understand the pronunciation. Most of the manual focuses on the pronunciation of the words rather than the way they are written in Arabic.

Work through the booklet section by section. This will give students a good grasp of how to deal with passengers as they pass through an airport.
